PALLICARE FUNDAMENTALS

PalliCare Fundamentals is a Certificate program aims to provide participants with core understanding of the key aspects of palliative care.

The program would benefit those entering any care or palliative care practice, those update skills at all levels and for those health professionals consolidating prior learning as a professional development activity.

Suitable for:

Block 1: Health Care Professionals (6 Units held from February - April)

Block 2: Volunteers, Carers & Family (6 Units held from May - July)

Block 3: Aged Care (6 Units held from August - October)

Delivery:

Online interactive and facilitated sessions. 6 2-hour / 1.5-hour units delivered over 12 weeks. Units are available for individual attendance. Offered three times per year.

Investment:

PCT Member: \$150.00 for the course or \$30.00 per individual unit. Includes resources + GST & Booking Fee.

Non-Member: \$250.00 for the course or \$50.00 per individual unit.

SPEAKER SERIES

Palliative Care Tasmania's Speaker Series is a mix of local national and international industry experts covering specialty palliative and end of life topics.

Speakers are selected to inform both the sector and the community and include presentations from professionals, interactive sessions and robust conversations.

Health Care Professionals providing information to the public, Aged Care staff, Carers, Volunteers, HACC or CHSP providers, community groups and individuals.

Delivery:

Online or In-person session with live Q&A as part of the session.

Free to PCT Members and open to the public:

Cost may apply to non-Members depending on the speaker. This will be noted prior to the event.
